- Was actually Greek, not Egyptian
- She became pharaoh when she was just 18 and was the last pharaoh of Ancient Egypt
- Ruled Egypt for roughly 17 years
- Could speak several languages
- She wasn't the first Cleopatra, she was actually the seventh
- Made her husband kill her sister!

Fact file

- Became pharaoh at just 9
- Nicknamed the boy king
- He died at just 18
- His tomb was found in 1922, with around 5000 treasures
- His famous gold burial mask weighs about 10 kilograms
- His name means "living image of Amun" - king of the gods
