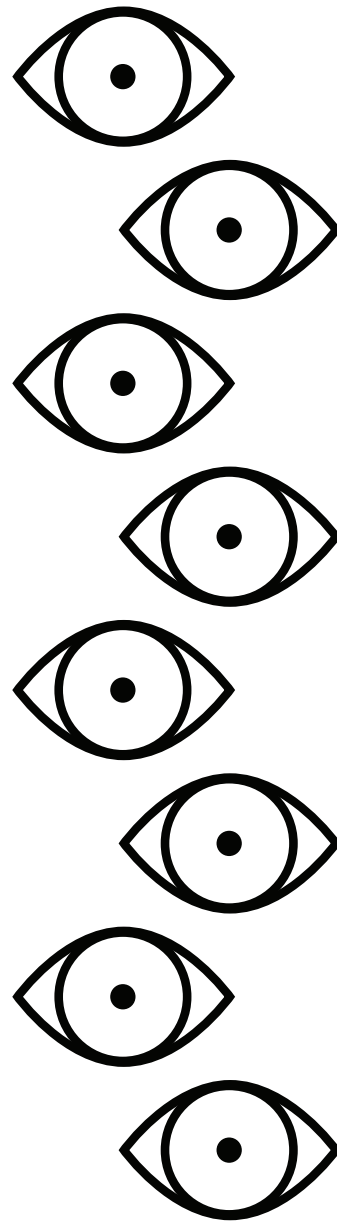


The most common eye colour in the world is brown!

dragonfly

Huge compound eyes, which help them **see all around** them.



mantis shrimp

The most amazing eyes in the world. Can **detect things we can't see**.



chameleon

Can move each eye in **different directions** at the same time.

The **largest eye** on Earth, at 11 inches across, about the size of a **football!**
