Treasure Map



You'll need:

child-safe scissors

thick white paper

colouring pens

teabags

Arrr!

1

Ask an adult to help tear all the edges of the white paper.



2

Scrunch up the paper into a ball and then smooth it out flat. Cut out all the shapes. Then glue them on to your map.

Ahoy!

Pop two used teabags into a cup of cold water and stir gently.

4

Carefully squeeze the teabag to remove the water. Gently dab it all over the map. Allow to dry.

5

Use your colouring pens to add a dotted line trail and, of course, a big 'X' for the treasure.
